The Camino de Santiago – The Way of Saint James - represents more than one thousand years of history and tradition. Legend has it that the remains of Jesus's apostle Saint James the Greater lie in Santiago. Its historical, cultural and spiritual path tell a thousand tales of the countless pilgrims that have walked the 4 main routes over the centuries.

Why You'll ♥ This Adventure:

- ♥ **El Camino de Santiago - the Portugal Coastal trek** - historic dedicated bike path
- ♥ **Self-Guided** as a group, so lots of flexibility to stop and explore whenever, wherever
- ♥ **All E-Bikes** – easy pace pedaling as a small group
- ♥ **Constant stops** for photos, coffee/drinks, snacks, exploring
- ♥ **SAG van** (those not cycling will come along by car) available if you need a break
- ♥ The main "UP" day – **we put our bikes (and us) on the train** to avoid the steep climbs, and wind up at our hot springs hotel for a soak and lovely evening
- ♥ **Easy pace cycling over 4½ days / 3 – 4 hours a day** with many enjoyable stops – around 23 – 39 miles a day.

Itinerary in brief

- ♥ **Optional Pre-Day:** Arrive Porto early, or Lisbon, Portugal (transfer to Porto next morn)
- ♥ **Day 1:** Arrive to Porto – relax, explore
- ♥ **Day 2:** Pedal Porto to Povia de Varzim (26 miles)
- ♥ **Day 3:** Pedal Povia de Varzim to Viana do Castelo (33 miles)
- ♥ **Day 4:** Pedal Viana do Castelo to Bairo (39 miles) *
- ♥ **Day 5:** Pedal Bairo to Vigo (13 miles); train to Santo Antonino (20 miles of mostly UP); cycle to Caldas de Reis (8 miles)
- ♥ **Day 6:** Pedal Caldas de Reis to Santiago (26 miles). Receive our Camino Certificate
- ♥ **Day 7:** Santiago at leisure. Depart.

The history of el Camino de Santiago: In English, “el Camino de Santiago” means “*the Way of Saint James*” and it represents the pilgrimage to the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in northwestern Spain. The Adventure Logistics:

- Adventure begins in Porto, Portugal and ends in Santiago de Compostella, Spain
- Total pedal – 145 miles (of the 165 mile Coastal trail) over 4½ days
- 6-nights accommodations including breakfast
- Includes E-bicycle for 5 days; Panniers
- Includes 24/7 Support by phone
- Includes Luggage transferred daily to each hotel. Only pedal with your pannier and/or day pack
- Includes Trip notes, Route guide, Pilgrim pack, luggage tags
- Option \$ extra - to fly into Lisbon; one night hotel and train to Porto the next morn
- Option \$ extra - fly into Porto one night early

Not Included: flight to Portugal; additional pre-night in Lisbon; train to Porto; adult beverages; optional tours
